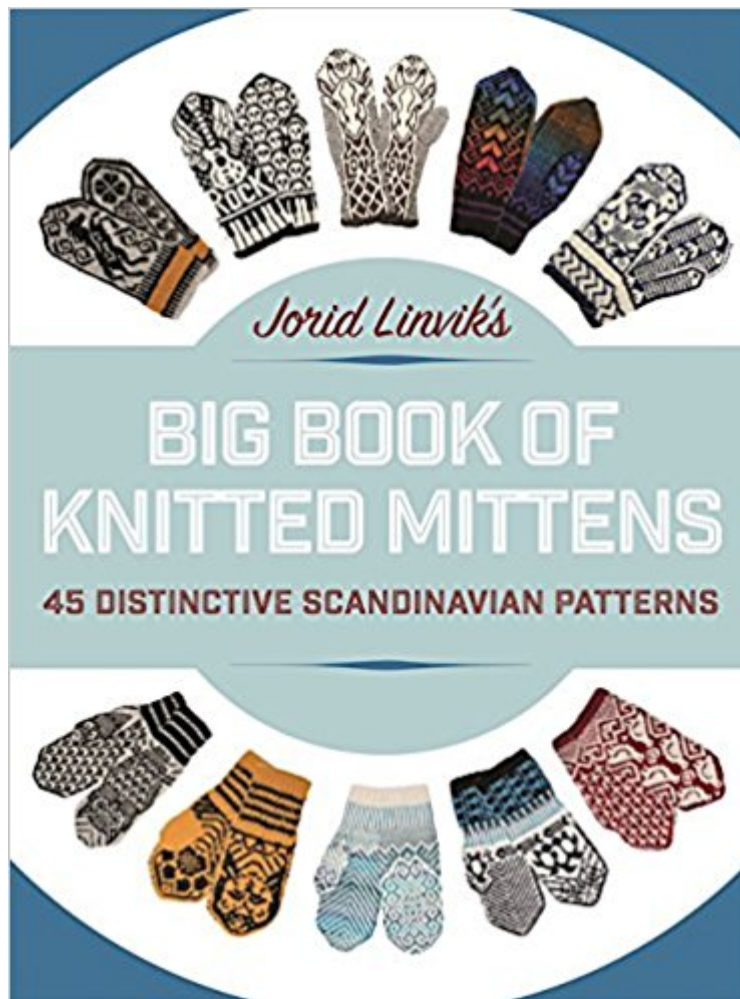

Most of the designs are animal-inspired and are definitely not the standard geometric repeating designs that many Scandinavian books offer, so if you're looking for an uber-traditional book of patterns this probably isn't the book for you. For me, though, I really appreciate these designs, and based on the number of requests I've already gotten from friends and family, these patterns will be a hit for any recipient. I'll update this review once I've knit a few of the designs and can weigh in on errata, clarity of patterns, etc.

This is a wonderful book. It has a great section at the beginning on knitting mittens. Then there are the wonderful mitten patterns. Then at the end, there is a section about designing your own mittens.
